Form: Ground cover Height: 0.2 – 0.5 m Spread: 0.3 – 1 m Flowers: Yellow Type: Insignificant Flowering time: Spring, Summer

Ecological functions:



Soils: sand, clay or loam; alkaline or neutral

Seed collecting: collect heads that are matured, pale yellow, a bit spongy and contain brown seeds.

Seed treatment: none

Sowing requirements: sow on top of damp soil and cover with a layer of gravel. Sow in Autumn. Requires good drainage.

Position: full sun, part shade.

Supplementary watering: minimal

Uses: a dwarf perennial herb for mixed native landscapes, rockeries and borders. Food host to Australian Painted Lady (*Vanessa kershawi*).

Germination rate: 3 to 7 weeks

Notes: dies back in winter. Grows from cuttings.
