

Chrysocephalum semipapposum **Yellow Buttons**







Adult Australian Painted Lady

(Seeds of South Australia)

(Richter, R, iNaturalist Australia)

(Hunt, L, SA Butterflies & Moths)

Form: *Ground cover* **Height:** 0.2 – 1 *m*

Spread: $0.5 - 1.5 \, m$ **Flowers:** Yellow

Type: Clusters

Flowering time: Spring, Summer

Ecological functions:





Soils: sand, clay or loam; acidic, alkaline or neutral

Germination rate: 2 to 4 weeks

Seed collecting: collect whole heads that are brown and fluffy or collect just the seeds by plucking it off with your fingers. Mature seeds can be easily removed.

Seed treatment: none. Seeds are non-dormant, viable seed should germinate readily.

Sowing requirements: press seed onto damp soil and cover with a layer of gravel. Sow in Autumn. Requires well-drained soils.

Position: full sun

Supplementary watering: minimal

Uses: perennial herb for mixed native landscapes, parks and reserves. Suitable for mass planting or informal drifts, spreads by suckering. Food host to Australian Painted Lady (Vanessa kershawi).

Notes: mixed form cultivars available.
