

Coronidium scorpioides **Button Everlasting**









Adult Australian Painted Lady

(Seeds of South Australia)

(Moodie, I D.B., iNaturalist Australia) (Richter, R, iNaturalist Australia)

Form: Low shrub

Height: $0.2 - 0.5 \, m$

Spread: 0.2 - 0.3 m **Flowers:** Yellow

Type: Clusters

(Hunt, L, SA Butterflies & Moths)

Flowering time: Spring, Winter

Germination rate: 3 to 4 weeks

Ecological functions:





Soils: sand, clay or loam; acidic, alkaline or neutral

Seed collecting: cut off mature heads and place in a container, keep dry. Flower heads will fall apart. Add small amount of insecticide to collected material before sorting.

Seed treatment: none

Sowing requirements: sow on top of damp soil and cover with a layer of gravel. Sow in Autumn-Spring. Sow in full sun, not under shadecloth. Keep ants off.

Position: full sun

Supplementary watering: minimal

Uses: hardy perennial with yellow papery bracts under-planting. Useful as a filler or edging plant. Good for under planting around taller trees. Food source of Australian Painted Lady (Vanessa kershawi).

Notes: grows best in moist soils. Fomerly known as Helichrysum scorpioides.
