

Vittadinia gracilis Wooly New Holland Daisy







(Seeds of South Australia)

Form: Low shrub **Height:** 0.5 - 1 m

(Seeds of South Australia)

Spread: 0.5 – 1 m

Flowers: Blue

(Seeds of South Australia)

Type: Daisy Flowering time: Spring, Summer

Ecological functions:





Soils: *clay or loam; alkaline or neutral*

Seed collecting: collect seedheads from plants.

Seed treatment: none

Sowing requirements: sprinkle seeds on top of damp soil and cover with a layer of gravel. Sow in Autumn. Requires well-drained soils.

Position: full sun

Supplementary watering: minimal

Uses: hardy, perennial self-seeding herb for borders, verges and roundabouts. Mass planted as an understorey or in drifts in native landscapes.

Germination rate: 1 to 3 weeks

Notes: short lived.
