

Ficinia (Isolepis) nodosa **Knobby Club Rush**

Form: Sedge or Flax

Height: 0.5 - 1.5 m

Spread: $0.6 - 2 \, m$ Flowers: Brown

Type: Globular Flowering time: All year round

Ecological functions:





Soils: gravel, sand or loam; acidic, alkaline or neutral

Germination rate: 3 to 6 weeks

Seed collecting: collect seed-heads that are brown and come off easily with your fingers.

Seed treatment: none

Sowing requirements: sow on top of damp soil and cover with a layer of gravel. Sow in Late Spring to Summer.

Position: full sun, part shade.

Supplementary watering: none

Uses: planted singly or in groups for mixed landscapes as a feature or mass planted, in borders, verges, median strips roundabouts. Extremely hardy and variable, can be used as a sand-binder.

Notes: Tends to grow in clumps, do not thin out.
