**Form:** *Medium shrub* **Height:** 0.3 – 1.5 *m* 

Spread: 1-2 mFlowers: Green Type: Spikes

Flowering time: All year round

Ecological functions:





Soils: sand, clay or loam; alkaline or neutral

Germination rate: 2 to 4 weeks

Seed collecting: collect fruits that have started to dry and turn pale. Check for viable seed inside the fruit before collecting.

**Seed treatment:** none

Sowing requirements: cover with 2 mm of damp soil and firm gently. Then cover with a layer of gravel.

**Position:** full sun, part shade.

Supplementary watering: none

**Uses:** soil and erosion control in high saline areas, parks and coastal reserves. Food host to Salt-bush Blue (Theclinesthe sserpentata) and other native butterfly caterpillars.

**Notes:** fire retardant as per SA Country Fire Service.
