Form: *Low shrub*



(Murfet, D, Seeds of South Australia)

Height: *0.2 – 0.3 m* **Spread:** *0.4 – 0.5 m* **Flowers:** *Purple*



(Seeds of South Australia)

Type: *Daisy*

Flowering time: *Autumn, Winter*

Ecological functions:



Soils: *sand, clay or loam; alkaline or neutral*

Germination rate: *1 to 3 weeks*

Seed collecting: collect seedheads from plants.

Seed treatment: none

Sowing requirements: sprinkle seeds on top of damp soil and cover with a layer of gravel. Sow in Autumn. Requires well-drained soils.

Position: full sun

Supplementary watering: minimal

Uses: hardy, perennial self-seeding herb for borders, verges and roundabouts mass planted as an understorey or in drifts in native landscapes.

Notes: short lived.
